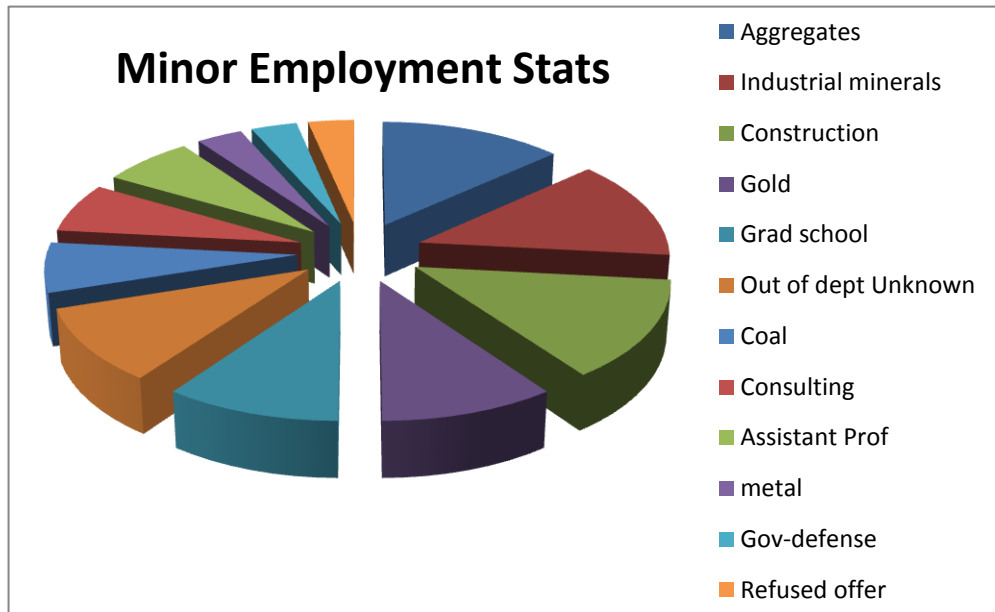


## Employment History of Explosives Engineering Graduates

Since the M.S. in Explosives Engineering is new, there are only 4 graduates of the program (as of Summer 2011). These went to work for a consulting company in Kentucky, an explosives company in Indiana, Homeland Defense and one is staying on for a PhD.

Of the 30 current graduates with explosives engineering minors (as of Fall 2009), 24 had a mining engineering BS, three an aerospace BS, one an engineering management BS and two had PhDs in Mining Engineering. The employment statistics are listed in descending order, starting at 12:00 and progressing clockwise.
